OLD BUSINESS

Transfer Station Update

The Commissioners held a general discussion regarding the Transfer Station on South Street. The Commissioners requested Attorney Donald Nagle draft a letter to the Town of Plymouth and DEP.

Vote-Bid-Construction of Reading and Storage Room-Registry of Deeds
Register Buckley presented the sole bid received for the construction of a reading and storage room for historic records at the Registry of Deeds, 50 Obery Street, Plymouth, MA. 16 vendors requested bid packages.

Commissioner Hanley made a motion to accept the bid received August 22, 2014, from Cape Associates, Inc. 345 Massasoit Road, Eastham, MA to construct a reading and storage room for historic records at the Plymouth County Registry of Deeds, 50 Obery Street, Plymouth, MA in the amount of \$206,818.00. Register Buckley is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents reasonably necessary to complete the project, pay any and all expenses required, and to take any other actions otherwise necessary. Chairman Pallotta seconded.
