Bidders must submit two (2) copies of their Bid with original signatures in appropriate places on each copy, along with a Corporate Vote, a Certificate of Non-Collusion, a Certificate of Tax Compliance and a Bid Bond, and other documents described in the Invitation for Bid documents. The Bid must be received by the Plymouth County Commissioners at their office no later than **3:00 p.m. June 26, 2018**. The clock located in the main administration office will be the official time piece. All Bids will be publicly opened and read. Bids must be received in a sealed envelope clearly marked in the lower left-hand corner "Public Service Vehicles- Ford".
