Executive Session

In Accordance with MGL, Chapter 30A, Section 21, held for the purpose to discuss strategy concerning union negotiations with SEIU and OPEIU, and to consider the purchase, exchange, lease or value of real property, located at 155 West Elm Street, Brockton, MA and the "Woodlot", Long Pond Road, Plymouth, including access options, if the chair declares that an open meeting may have a detrimental effect on the negotiating position of the governmental body. Both are considered unique properties by the Board. Offer letters have been signed and the Commissioners agreed to move to signing a P&S for the properties.
