In Accordance with MGL, Chapter 30A, Section 21, held for the purpose of updating and discussing strategy with respect to collective bargaining with the SEIU and OPEIU, and to discuss litigation with respect to the County of Plymouth v Town of Plymouth re. **Update on South Street Transfer Station/Landfill**

Attorney Don Nagle updated the Commissioners with respect to litigation for County of Plymouth v Town of Plymouth re. Plymouth Dump and 21E. Discovery and interrogatories are being compiled and Attorney Nagle would like approval on commencing prior to serving them. Commissioner consensus was for Attorney Nagle to move forward with delivery of interrogatories and document requests. The Commissioners asked for Attorney Nagle to send the list to them prior to communication.

**Update on Union Negotiations with the SEIU and the OPEIU**

The negotiating team reached agreement with the Registry Union on June 23. An overview of the agreement was handed out and the agreement was within parameters approved by the Commissioners at prior meetings. The Registry union ratified their agreement on June 28. The Commissioners will vote the contract in public session.

Administrator Basler updated the Commissioners on three SEIU Custodial employees that were hired during the summer of 2012. In review of work histories, it came to the attention that these three members had steps that were not in agreement with current practices. Administrator Basler discussed this issue and came to terms with Joan Pritchard and the terms were memorialized in a MOU. The Commissioners agreed to correct this issue in open session.

Motion made and seconded to end Executive Session and Return to Open Meeting. Chairman Pallotta called the roll: Commissioner Wright-Yes. Commissioner Hanley – Yes. Chairman Pallotta-Yes. Executive Session ended at 7:35 P.M.
