**Executive Session**

**County Farm, Plymouth, MA**

Attorney Resnick called into the meeting and updated the Commissioners by speakerphone on the progress of negotiations with Pat Lee, the Sheriff's Council, concerning the County Farm lease. Lee and Resnick continue to make progress and will seek to move the process ahead. The Commissioners agreed on one last effort or that Attorney Resnick should move ahead with filing the law suit. Attorney Resnick will set up a meeting with Lee for another round of discussions. The Administrator will send Attorney Resnick the County Farm insurance policy for review.

Attorney Resnick also updated the Commissioners on the Joyce Grievance process. Attorney Resnick stated that she gave an extension in filing for arbitration to SEIU Attorney John Magner in order to discuss the situation with the Commissioners. The Commissioners, after listening to council stated that they are prepared to move the grievance process ahead to go to arbitration and that Attorney Resnick should not settle the matter as the Treasurer followed all appropriate steps in the hiring process.

At 8:45 A.M. Commissioner Wright made the motion to exit Executive Session and enter back into Open Session.
