MEETING

EXECUTIVE SESSION

September 24, 2015

In Accordance with MGL, Chapter 30A, Section 21, held for the purpose of discussing the consideration of purchase, exchange or lease of real property and to discuss strategy with respect to collective bargaining and pending litigation, the Board voted to enter into Executive Session at 6:00 p.m. and to not return to open public session. Chairman Pallotta called the roll: Commissioner Hanley-Yes. Commissioner Wright-Yes. Chairman Pallotta-Yes.

**Update & Strategy for union negotiations-SEIU & OPEIU**

As directed by the Commissioners, Frank Basler presented a top to bottom review of the Commissioners' office, the Treasurer's office, Extension Services and the Maintenance Department. The plan was discussed along with the Administrator's rationale behind each finding. The plan included a reorganization of the Commissioners' office and Treasurers' office involving several union positions which would have to be impact bargained along with a new competency based hiring process led by a hiring search subcommittee. The Commissioners decided to individually review the plan during the week and discuss actions at the next scheduled meeting.

The Administrator stated that he was working on scheduling meetings with the unions for further negotiations and to hear the Gadles grievance.

**Discussion-Wood Lot (Assessors Map 88, Lot 54, Plymouth, MA)**

The Administrator also updated the Commissioners on a tour of the Wood Lot with the Open Space Committee and others. The group would like to propose a purchase of some of the land and will assess the feasibility of doing so.
