

PLYMOUTH COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MEETING

April 30, 2020

The Plymouth County Commissioners held a regular meeting via Zoom/Videoconference per amended open meeting law requirements, Thursday, April 30, 2020 at 6:00 p.m.

Chairman Daniel A. Pallotta, Commissioner Sandra M. Wright, and Commissioner Gregory M. Hanley were in attendance as well as Plymouth County Treasurer Thomas O'Brien, Plymouth County Register of Deeds John Buckley, County Attorney Shannon Resnick and Executive Assistant Nancy O'Rourke.

Chairman Pallotta requested the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silence for the victims of the COVID 19 pandemic.

CARES Act update, review and discussion

Chairman Pallotta presented a power point presentation of the CARES Act and the plans of the County to implement the program.

Chairman Pallotta briefed the members of the Plymouth County Advisory Board on the recent award of Federal CARES Act funds for Plymouth County of 90 million dollars. The State office of Administration and Finance requested that the County defer the money to the state. The County Commissioners agreed Plymouth County member towns and the City of Brockton would receive the funds much quicker and feel the administration of the fund can be handled by the County.

Chairman of the Advisory Board Michael Bradley expressed support of the ability of the county to administer the grant program and is very confident it will be a success.

Each member was then given the opportunity to comment. After hearing from all members Chairman Pallotta advised the power point presentation would be emailed to all Town Managers and Administrators. Additional guidance will be forthcoming to each Town Manager and Administrator as to how the payments will be processed.
